It has been another busy and productive week. The range and quality of work is very impressive across the school. Here are a few examples of learning experiences in some classrooms.

This week, Year 4 have enjoyed learning how to flexibly partition numbers to 10,000 and writing a diary entry linked to 'The Butterfly Lion'. Reception have been having fun (and making a mess!) with cornflour. The Year 1 children have been counting backwards within 10, today they created their own rockets and number lines with chalk outside to count down from a variety of numbers with talk partners, taking turns and enjoying some sunshine too! Year 2 have been continuing their learning about the story of the Three Little Pigs and have enjoyed performing the story using the actions they came up with. It was wonderful to see Year 6 developing their tag rugby skills outside on the field earlier today, as well as other PE lessons in Year 3 and 5.

The teachers in Year 1 to Year 6 have created an overview of learning intentions for the half term. They will be sent to you shortly for your reference. Mrs Turner-Proud will send a similar document on Tapestry next week for the Reception children.
