OUR LEARNING

TRADITIONAL TALES AND PEOPLE WHO HELP US

This half term are going to be reading Goldilocks and the 3 Bears, getting to know the characters, main themes and story language.

MATHS

Number:

We will be extending and consolidating our understanding of the composition of numbers to 10, doubles, odd and even numbers and addition. We will also be practicing counting and recognising numbers to 20 and beyond.

Shape, Space and Measures:

We will continue exploring 2D and 3D shapes, comparing by length, weight and capacity and how to continue, copy and create repeating patterns.

PHONICS

This half term we will be building, writing and reading words and sentences using the phonemes, digraphs and trigraphs we have learnt. Focusing on saying the sounds as we write and using our high frequency words.

READING AND WRITING

Please continue reading at least 5 times a week, it is important for children to read the same book several times to develop decoding skills, confidence and fluency.

We are working hard to form letters correctly when writing and any support at home would be appreciated
